## Things to remember the first few weeks...

- The lobby will be very crowded. Things will settle down as everyone gets into a routine.
- There will be several classes going on at the same time. Classes may let out at the same time another is entering. Please be mindful of students who need to change in order to attend the next class.
- For some classes, the first few weeks will be reviewing what we learned last year, so the dancers can focus and remember the concepts.
- A good part of the first few classes will be spent on classroom routine and etiquette.

- The youngest dancers will often have tears or anxiety the first few weeks. This is normal. The teachers are trained to handle this. It will not be uncommon for teachers to hold students until things settle down. The best way to ensure success is to reassure your dancer that they will have fun and do not enter the classroom or open the door.
- Please have dancers in combo classes bring a small dance bag for their second pair of shoes.
- Please have dancers use the restroom before class. It is very distracting for students to leave or walk through the classroom.
- Please keep noise down to a minimum in the lobby and at the viewing window.
- You do not have to wait in the lobby during your dancers' class. However, you must be on time for pick up.
